

MINUTES

REEDLEY AIRPORT COMMISSION MEETING

Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER
A meeting of the Reedley Airport Commission was held at the Reedley Community Center, 100 N. East Avenue, Reedley, California and called to order by Carl Smith at 04:03 p.m.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
 - A. Motion by Commissioner Jewell, seconded by Commissioner Agrifoglio to approve the August 26, 2021 Airport Commission minutes. Motion carried.
4. PUBLIC DISCUSSION –
 - A. Chief Isaak stated he was asked by Commissioner Jewell to attend the Airport Commission meeting in regards to a fire station being stationed out at the Reedley Municipal Airport.
5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS
 - A. **2021 Airport Barbeque Planning Saturday, October 2, 2021** – Reid shared with the Commission masks and health checks will be mandatory for anyone participating in the airplane rides. The airplane rides should take no longer than 15 minutes and each airplane can hold 2-3 individuals. Certificates of Insurance are required for anyone providing airplane rides. Reid stated there will be a pilot briefing prior to the airplane rides which will provide the route for the airplane rides and other important details. Reid shared with the Commission, Cheney and herself will be out at the Airport at 7:30a.m. for anyone that is available to help set up. Guest Speaker Susan Bell plans to drive in. Reid stated a reimbursement for Bell’s fuel will be provided.
