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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
CITY OF REEDLEY & COMMUNITY YOUTH MINISTRIES  
August 9, 2016

This Memorandum of Understanding, herein referred to as "MOU" is entered into by and between City of Reedley (CITY) and Community Youth Ministries (CYM) for the purpose of services for the Save the Children Sponsorship afterschool programs at the following site; Sheridan.

### Roles and Responsibilities

CITY will bill CYM for the amount of actual expenses incurred during the quarterly period, not to exceed the total school site budget allotted to them for personnel, materials and payroll costs incurred by the school sites serves related to the Save the Children Sponsorship Program.

Payment to the CITY will be processed immediately upon CYM receipt of the quarterly invoices and backup reports.

CITY will generate and submit to CYM a quarterly budget report of actual expenditures. Reports are due by or before the following dates; October 15, 2016, January 15, 2017, April 15, 2017 and July 15, 2017.

### Terms of this MOU

By entering into this MOU all parties recognize and agree to:

1. Work collaboratively as partners to ensure the success of this program.
2. That this agreement may be modified at any time with written consent.
3. That certain information received in the course of business is confidential according to lay and policy and agrees to respect requirements in this regard.
4. That availability of funds may have a bearing on the ability to implement all or parts of this agreement.
5. That CITY and CYM shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws in the performance of these services.

This MOU shall be in effect August 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017.

**Indemnification**

CYM hold harmless and defend CITY and each of its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers from any and all loss, liability, fines, penalties, forfeitures, costs and damages (whether in contract, tort or strict liability, including but not limited to personal injury, death at any time and property damage) incurred by the CYM, CITY or any other person, and from any and all claims, demands and actions in law or equity (including attorney's fees and litigation expenses), arising or alleged to have arisen directly or indirectly from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions, or willful misconduct of CYM or any of its officers, officials, employees, agents or volunteers in the performance of this Agreement.

CITY shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend CYM and each of its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers from any and all loss, liability, fines, penalties, forfeitures, costs and damages (whether in contract, tort or strict liability, including but not limited to personal injury, death at any time and property damage) incurred by CITY, CYM or any other person, and from any and all claims, demands and actions in law or equity (including attorney's fees and litigation expenses), arising or alleged to have arisen directly or indirectly from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions, or willful misconduct of CITY or any of its officers, officials, employees, agents or volunteers in the performance of this Agreement; provided nothing herein shall constitute a waiver by CITY of governmental immunities including California Government Code section 810 et seq.

CYM agrees that this Agreement shall in no way act to abrogate or waive any immunities available to CITY under the Tort Claims Act of the State of California.

In the event of concurrent negligence on the part of CYM or any of its officers, officials, employees, agents or volunteers, and CITY or any of its officers, officials, employees, agents or volunteers, the liability for any and all such claims, demands and actions in law or equity for such losses, fines, penalties, forfeitures, costs and damages shall be apportioned under the State of California's theory of comparative negligence as presently established or as may be modified hereafter.

This section shall survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.



- C) ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2016-075 AMENDING THE 2016-17 ADOPTED BUDGET APPROPRIATING \$6,071 IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE SAVE THE CHILDREN SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

### RECOMMENDATION

Approve and authorize the City Manager to sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Kings Canyon Unified School District (KCUSD) to expand services within the After School Program at Washington School with Save the Children Funding, authorize City Manager to sign the MOU with Community Youth Ministries (CYM) to provide funding to support the Save the Children Sponsorship Program at Sheridan School site, and adopt

Resolution No. 2016-075 amending the 2016-17 Adopted Budget appropriating \$6,071 in General Fund to the Save the Children Sponsorship Program.

## **BACKGROUND**

There are two components to the Save the Children Program, Literacy and Sponsorship.

### **Literacy:**

Since 2008, the City of Reedley has incorporated the Save the Children literacy program allowing the expansion of services to the after school program at Washington School. The Memorandum of Understanding with KCUSD outlines the reporting and reimbursement processes.

During the 2016-17 budget process, a final decision had not been made by Save the Children and City staff regarding the costs associated with the Literacy Program. At that time, City staff submitted their best estimate based on last year's program. Once the final Literacy budget was agreed upon by Save the Children and City staff, the City of Reedley budget was already adopted. At this time, it appears that the budget accurately reflects expenditures and revenues. Any adjustments will be made at mid-year.

### **Sponsorship:**

After discussions between Save the Children, CYM and City staff, all parties agreed that the approach for monitoring the sponsorship portion of the program at Sheridan and Washington school sites will be served by two part-time City employees. Because each school site has a portion of the sponsorship budget, the City will invoice CYM for reimbursement of all costs related to the programs that take place at Sheridan that is CYM's after school programs.

During the 2016-17 City budget process, a decision had not yet been made on the monitoring of the sponsorship program. After the adoption of the budget, Save the Children, CYM and City staff decided that the sponsorship program would continue to be supervised by City staff. Because of this, the City of Reedley budget needs to be amended to reflect actual numbers for the sponsorship portion of the program.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

All part time personnel and supplies related to the program will be reimbursed, amending the budget by \$6,071 to reflect actual costs.

## **PRIOR COUNCIL ACTIONS**

The after school program is comprised of three different funding sources. On June 14, 2016, City Council approved the Proposition 49 (ASES) funding which has been the main funding source for the after school program.
