NEW STAY-AT-HOME ORDER TO TAKE EFFECT SUNDAY AT MIDNIGHT

In response to the dramatic rise in COVID-19 cases in California and a dire lack of ICU bed space around the State, the Governor issued a new Stay-At-Home Order that impacts Reedley residents and businesses. All residents are urged to stay home and not to gather with other people for at least three weeks.

The Order requires:

- Restaurants may only be open for take-out and delivery. No indoor or outdoor dining allowed.
- Salons and personal care services must close.
- All non-essential travel is prohibited.
- All social gatherings are prohibited.
- Gyms may operate outdoors only.
- Churches may gather outdoor only at limited size.
- All retail may remain open but at a limited capacity to minimize social contact.
- All indoor and outdoor playgrounds are closed.
- Schools that had previously opened under waivers may remain open, subject to public health orders.

All Reedley residents and businesses are reminded to follow the COVID-19 safety protocols, including wearing a face covering or mask when around others, wash your hands frequently, stay at least 6 feet apart from others, avoid non-essential gatherings.

The Fresno County Public Health Department will evaluate the number of ICU cases in 3 weeks and will update the public at that time on the status of reopening the County. Restrictions may remain in place until there is at least a 15% open capacity of ICU beds in hospitals within the San Joaquin Valley region.
